Dr. Nobie Stone retired from NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center, where he served as chief scientist for two Space Shuttle Missions and was Principal Investigator or Co-Investigator for science experiments on eight additional space missions. His experimental research on the wakes of orbiting spacecraft is internationally recognized. He continues to work part time, supporting NASA in the development of advanced in-space propulsion technologies.

Dr. Stone received his BS and MS degrees from Florida State University and his PhD from The University of Alabama-Huntsville (UAH). He has served on the faculty of the UAH graduate school and has authored more than 150 technical publications.

Dr. Stone serves as an elder and adult Bible class teacher for the Mayfair Church of Christ in Huntsville, Alabama. He is married and has three children and six grandchildren.
